Also includes a letter to Annabel from Gladys dated 1949 which discusses Birch Hill farm and road, which apparently became Clam Bay as well as the "famous Campbell Grant." Discusses the location of the road and mentions Walter, Alice, and Eddy Stoddard as it went by their properties.
